

## Instructions for the P+ Remote for Android & iOS tablets & smartphones

### 1) Bring the VR glasses into the Wi-Fi

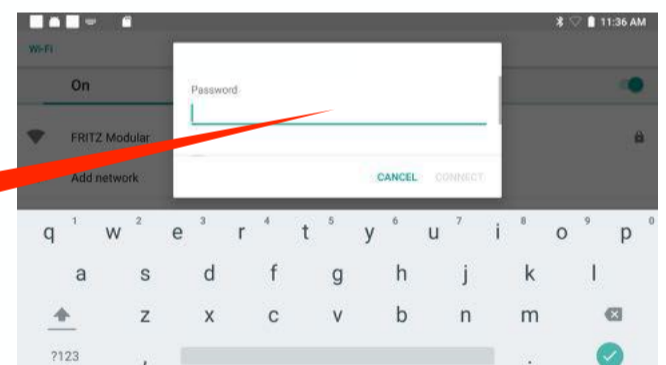
- In the main menu, click on the Wi-Fi symbol with the green laser beam at the bottom left

- In the Wi-Fi menu, enter the Wi-Fi password on the virtual keyboard and press "Connect"

### 2) Bring the tablet or smartphone into the same Wi-Fi

- Enter the Wi-Fi password in the tablet under "Settings" under "Network & Internet"

Alternatively, you can set up a hotspot with your Android smartphone or tablet and connect the VR glasses to it.

**Please note:** This hotspot option only works with Android devices.

### 3) Download the P+ Remote App from the App Stores:

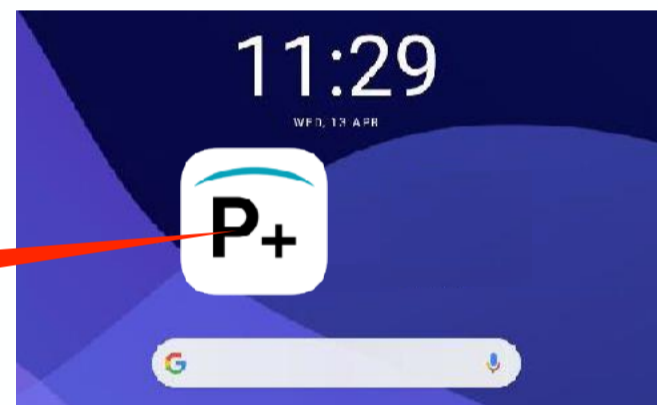

### 4) On the tablet or smartphone

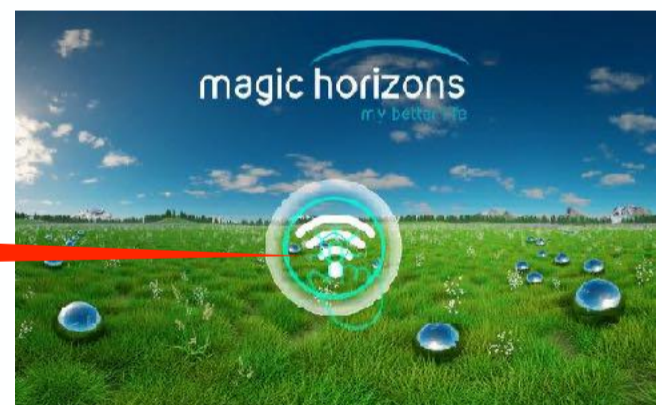
- Start the P+ Remote App

- Click on the flashing Wi-Fi icon to connect

### 5) In the VR glasses

- Click on the „connect“ **chain-icon** with the green laser beam
- The VR glasses are connecting automatically

### Important for Apple iOS devices:

- When you open the P+ app for the first time, a message appears:
- „P+ Remote would like to connect devices on your local network“
- Click on "**Allow**" – otherwise the P+ app will not work.
- Then **close** the P+ app on the iOS device and **restart** the P+ app again.

## 6) On the tablet or Smartphone

- You can connect up to 10 VR glasses depending on your local Wi-Fi speed
- You see an **orange** number for each connected VR glass
- When all VR glasses are connected press „All VR glasses registered“

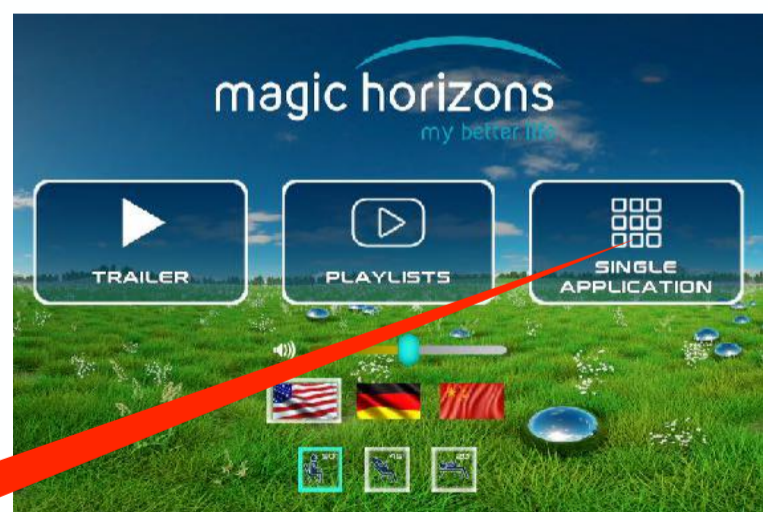

**The VR glasses and tablet or smartphone are now connected.  
The VR glasses are now controlled by the tablet or smartphone.**

## 7) Tablet operation

- In the tablet main menu, you can choose between the Trailer, the Playlists and the Single Application, set the language, volume and the sitting/lying position



Single application

- The individual VR applications are started in the Single Application menu
- Use the white arrows to scroll to more VR applications
- Clicking on the white door symbol at the bottom takes you back to the main menu



- After clicking on a VR application, it starts and you are in the playback menu
- There you can adjust the volume, pause, see a video that shows what is happening in the VR glasses and see the remaining time
- If multiple VR glasses are connected you can switch between them by clicking on the VR head symbol
- Clicking on the "X" symbol ends the running VR application and you are back in the Single Application menu
